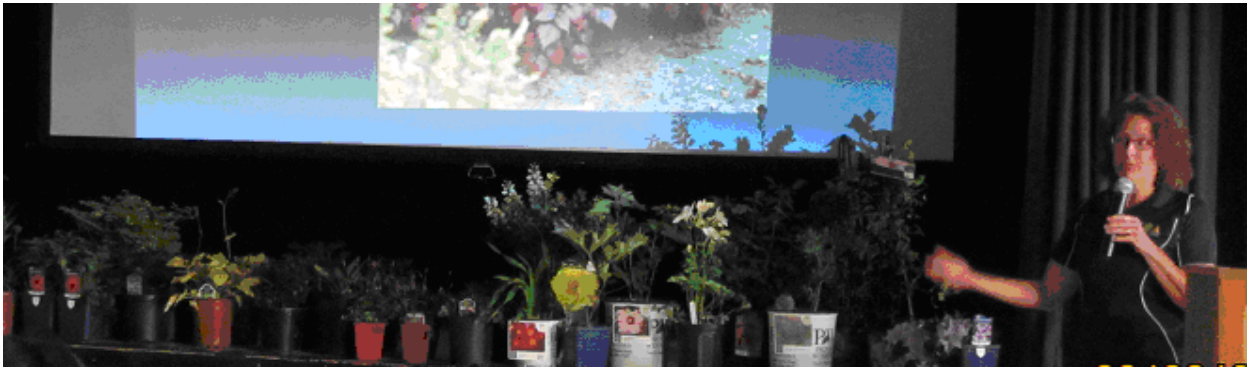
#### **FIELD TRIP TO PERTH AREA GARDENS – Saturday July 25**
